Taxes and fuel charges totaling **\$701 USD** comprised of **\$370.60** for fuel charges (subject to airline increase up to 30-days before departure) and **\$330.40** for taxes (including U.S. federal inspection fees, airport taxes international air transportation tax, agricultural tax, other government-imposed fees such as the September 11th Security fee up to \$10 per person, passenger facility charges up to \$18 per person, federal domestic flight segment fees up to \$3.50 per segment and U.S. and International arrival and departure, and other government imposed fees up to \$300 per person).

NOT INCLUDED IN PRICE:

Passports, visa/ETA, vaccinations (if required), laundry, lunches not on the tour menu (food outside of the contracted menu will be billed prior to leaving the hotel or restaurant), excursions not listed, telephone/international data, mini-bar, alcohol, other beverages, airport transfers on non-qualifying flights, portage at airports, excess baggage fees, additional airline fees after registration, travel insurance, and all other items not explicitly mentioned.

PAYMENTS & FEES:

A non-refundable deposit of \$500 per person is due upon registration, with a second deposit of \$500 per person required within 21 days thereafter.

Credit cards are only accepted for the initial \$500 deposit; subsequent payments must be in check, ACH transfer, bill payment, or wire transfer;

all payments are required in US Funds.

Final payment is due no later than 120 days prior to departure.

Registrations after 120 days require full payment and may incur a \$300 late fee if received 119-90 days before departure. **Failure to make final payment by 90 days prior to departure results in automatic cancellation, forfeiture of the \$500 deposit, and potential additional fees.**

Imagine Tours and Travel, LLC (hereafter referred to as *Imagine*) reserves the right to impose a surcharge if the dollar declines by more than 2% against the destination currency based on booking date (04/07/26).

GROUP SIZE & SUPPLEMENTS:

Tour pricing assumes a minimum group size of 20 passengers.

Smaller groups may incur supplements:

- \$150 per person (19-16 travelers)
- \$195 per person (15-14 travelers)
- \$295 per person (13-12 travelers)

Tours with fewer than 12 travelers may be canceled due to insufficient participation.

ACCOMMODATIONS:

Price is based on double occupancy (two people sharing a room).

Single rooms may be smaller than double rooms and, when available, incur an **additional supplemental charge of \$2,135 for the basic itinerary.** Roommates are assigned if available; otherwise, single-room occupancy may apply. *Roommates may be assigned as late as 120 days prior to departure when applicable.*

ITINERARY & CHANGES:

Imagine reserves the right to adjust itineraries due to airline schedule changes. Changes requiring extra nights incur \$195 per person per night (\$295 for single rooms). You will be notified in writing of said changes when possible. Meals for additional overnights are not included. Changes and/or deviations from the program and/or departure city listed by the passenger must be provided in writing no later than 120 days prior to departure.

All deviations are subject to a \$250 administrative fee plus applicable airline fees. **All tours are made final at 90 days prior to departure.**

No changes (including additions) may be made after this time.

LAND ONLY:

Land Only price is \$5,645 per person, excluding international flights.

Land Only passengers may be responsible for transfers and/or additional overnights incurred by booking their own flights. Passengers changing from the regular tour (with group airfare) to Land Only after 120 days prior to departure will be charged a fee of \$195 per person.

AIRLINE TICKETS & SEATING:

Flight routing is at the sole discretion of the airline, not *Imagine*. *Imagine* does not guarantee passengers will be on the most direct flight or flying together to the final destination (especially prior to 120 days of departure). Flights are economy class on IATA/ARC carriers with non-refundable, non-amendable tickets for groups of 10 or more. Group airfare pricing is based on the original group air contract secured by *Imagine*. Once contracted air inventory has been filled, any additional airfare secured for passengers—whether due to late registration, post-final payment additions, or changes requested by the passenger—**may be subject to increased costs**, which are the **responsibility of the passenger**. As such, *Imagine* cannot guarantee that all travelers will be booked on the same flights, particularly for passengers added after the final payment deadline as outlined in *PAYMENTS & FEES*, if airfare is applicable. Due to group rates, *Imagine* does not participate in or allow passengers to use points, miles, vouchers, or other airline-related programs on group contracted airfare. Seat upgrades,

cabin/class upgrades, or paid seating enhancements are not available through *Imagine* on group contracted airfare. All airfare provided under group contracts is economy class only. Seating requests are at the discretion of the applicable airline and cannot be guaranteed. All requests, including seating, dietary restrictions, and/or other accommodations must be made in writing prior to 120 days of departure. Any specific requests regarding seat assignments, seat upgrades, or cabin/class changes must be handled directly with the airline if permitted under the airline's fare rules once tickets have been issued, and remain subject to airline policies, availability, and additional fees. *Imagine* is unable to request, manage, or guarantee these changes on behalf of the passenger. Airline changes, if allowable, made by the passenger after 120 days prior to departure will incur additional fees. Individual ticketing fees and/or deposits may apply in certain situations. **These fees can be up to \$2,000 per person and will be applied to the final balance.**

FLIGHT TIMES:

All flight times are subject to change without notice. *Imagine* is not liable for expenses resulting from flight delays or changes. If making your own flight arrangements to a departure city or any other portion of your trip, we recommend obtaining a ticket which can be changed without large penalties. All passengers are responsible for reconfirming their flights with the airline 24 hours prior to departure.

PASSPORTS & VISAS:

Passengers must ensure their **passports are valid for at least six months beyond the return date of their trip** and submit a valid passport copy to our office no later than 120 days prior to departure. Visa requirements vary by country, and it is each passenger's responsibility to obtain necessary visas prior to travel. ***Imagine* is not liable for obtaining any required travel visas.**

TRIP RESCHEDULING:

Imagine and/or the group leader/organization reserves the right to reschedule the trip to **future dates and/or a different destination** due to governmental action, pandemics, wars, or other circumstances beyond their control. Travelers unable to travel on the new dates or to the updated destination may transfer to another tour within one year of the original travel dates, subject to fees of up to \$300 per person, plus any applicable fees imposed by ground operators, airlines, or other vendors.

CANCELLATION FEES:

Passengers cancelling from the day of registration up to 121 days prior to departure **will be charged a \$500 administrative fee** plus any airline penalties, if applicable. If passenger cancellation forces a roommate into a single room, the canceled passenger may be charged their single room fee. ↴

The ITINERARY

Day 1–2 – March 13–14, Saturday–Sunday: Arrive in Israel

We will depart from the USA, and upon arrival in **Israel**, we will be greeted and transferred to the Vert Lagoon Hotel in **Netanya**. Here, we enjoy a delightful dinner together and a well-deserved sleep.

Day 3 – March 15, Monday: From the Mediterranean to the Sea of Galilee

We start our day by exploring the **Crusader Tunnel in Acco**, located in the area of the **Tribe of Asher**. Then we'll visit **Mount Precipice in Nazareth**, where Jesus' hometown attempted to kill Him. Next we'll enjoy a traditional **first-century meal at Nazareth Village** (not included), experiencing the flavors of Jesus' day. Our journey continues to **Sepphoris**, the new city where Joseph and Jesus may have worked as carpenters. Dinner and overnight at the Gomeh Hotel on the **Sea of Galilee**.

Day 4 – March 16, Tuesday: Around the Sea of Galilee

Our day begins with a visit to the new excavations by the Sea of Galilee at **Bethsaida**, the hometown of Philip, Andrew, and Peter. We then head to **Gamla**, often called the "Masada of the north," and see the impressive view. At **Kursi**, we'll reflect on the passage of Jesus casting demons into the swine. We will explore in the Decapolis the site of **Hippos/Sussita**, perhaps the "city on a hill" Jesus mentioned. After the breathtaking view atop **Mount Arbel's** cliff, those who wish can follow Wayne down the cliff on an optional hike. Dinner and overnight at Gomeh Hotel.

Day 5 – March 17, Wednesday: Way Up North

We will visit **Hazor**, the city conquered by Joshua and later by the Assyrians. At the **Hulah Nature Reserve**, we'll consider how birds can teach us about our walk with God. We'll explore Nimrod's Fortress on **Mount Hermon**, the likely site of Jesus' Transfiguration. Next we'll enjoy the historical and panoramic views from **Mount Bental**. We end the day with a treat! An optional **rafting adventure on the Jordan River** will provide a unique way to experience this historic waterway. Dinner and overnight at Gomeh Hotel.

Day 6 – March 18, Thursday: Flowers, Shepherds, Prophets

This morning, we stroll through the biblical gardens of **Neot Kedummim**, experiencing the flora and fauna of the Bible. In **Bethlehem**, we'll visit the **Church of the Nativity**, where Jesus was born, and the **Shepherd's Field**, where the good news was first heard. We'll see **Solomon's Pools**, an ancient water reservoir system for Jerusalem. Our day ends with a visit to **En Kerem**, the hometown of **John the Baptist**. Dinner and overnight at the Cassia Hotel in **Jerusalem**.

Day 7 – March 19, Friday: Jerusalem's Old City

This morning, we discuss Jerusalem's significant geography outside the **Jaffa Gate**. We'll visit the newly renovated **Citadel Museum**, the best museum of Jerusalem's history. A **Ramparts Walk** from Jaffa Gate to Dung Gate will provide unique views of the Old City. We will pray at the **Western Wall**, the holiest site in Judaism. Our journey continues to the new excavations at the **Pool of Siloam**, where Jesus healed the blind man, and we'll walk up the **Pilgrims Path** to the **Southern Excavations**—where we'll walk (literally) where Jesus walked. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 8 – March 20, Saturday: In the Foothills

We begin at the fascinating **stalactite caves in Beth Shemesh**. Next at **Socoh**, we'll overlook the **Elah Valley**, the site of David's battle with Goliath. We will drive by the Levitical city of **Libnah**. And dig this! At **Mareshah**, we'll participate in a **real archaeological dig**, so bring some dirty clothes! We'll see the strategic city of **Lachish** as well as **Gezer's boundary stone**, understanding their importance in the Bible. Overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 9 – March 21, Sunday: Temple Mount and Mount of Olives

Early morning takes us to the **Temple Mount**, reflecting on its biblical significance past and future. We'll enjoy a private time in the **Grotto of Gethsemane**. We will see the **Kidron Valley**, known as the "Valley of Decision." From the **Judean Wilderness** overlook, we'll consider its role in the lives of David, John the Baptist, and Jesus. We will visit the **Good Samaritan Museum**, and in **Bethany** we'll descend to **Lazarus' tomb** and the home of Mary and Martha. Overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 10 – March 22, Monday: Day in Samaria

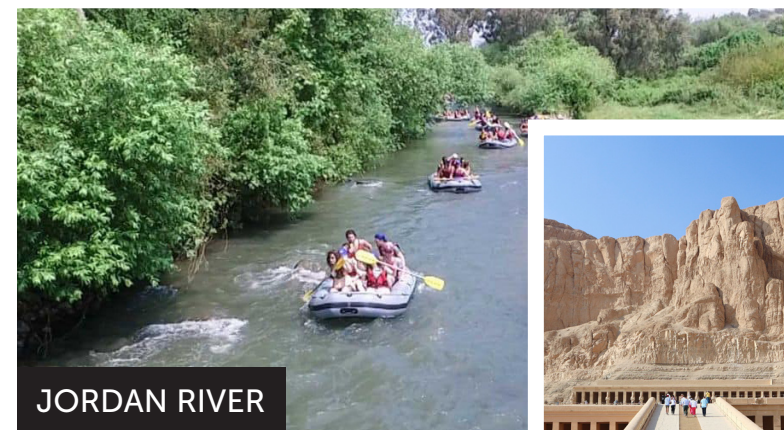
This VERY special day begins in the **Dothan Valley**, where Joseph's brothers sold him into slavery. We continue south to **Samaria/Sebaste**, the capital of the northern kingdom of Israel. At **Shechem** we'll see Abraham's first stop in the land and discuss this city's amazing history. At **Jacob's Well**, we'll read Jesus' encounter with the Samaritan woman. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 11 – March 23, Tuesday: Free Day in Jerusalem

Today offers a **free day in Jerusalem** to explore at our own pace. **Or you can join Wayne for an optional ten-mile hike on the Israel Trail from Tel Azekah to Beit Guvrin**. Other options for the day in the Old City include the **Herodian Mansion** and the **Burnt House**. We will meet for a **farewell dinner** at a local restaurant, sharing our favorite memories. Overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 12 – March 24, Wednesday: Fly Home

Those not participating in the Egypt extension will depart for home, carrying memories of a lifetime!

Day 12 – March 24, Wednesday: Flight to Cairo, Flight to Luxor

We transfer to the airport for our flight to **Cairo**. We then have a short flight to **Luxor**, where we will be assisted through customs, introduced to our guide and driver, and travel to our hotel near the Nile River for a delicious dinner and a well-deserved rest.

Day 13 – March 25, Thursday: Luxor—Valley of the Kings, Hatshepsut Temple, Luxor Temple

We'll get an early start at the **Valley of the Kings**, the burial place of many pharaohs, including those before and after the Exodus. We'll visit the amazing **Mortuary Temple of Hatshepsut**, the daughter of pharaoh who found Moses in the Nile. Then, we'll visit the amazing **Karnak Temple** and discover why Egypt always wanted to control the land of Israel. Overnight in Luxor.

Day 14 – March 26, Friday: Cairo—Dahshour Pyramids, St. Sergius Church, Nile River Felucca Ride

This morning we fly to **Cairo** and drive south to the **Red Pyramid, the Bent Pyramid, and the Black Pyramid**, the latter of which Joseph would have constructed for Pharaoh Sesostri III. In Cairo, we'll visit **St. Sergius Church** where tradition points to a cave where Joseph, Mary, and Jesus stayed when in Egypt. Then we'll enjoy an authentic **Felucca ride** on the Nile River. Overnight in Cairo.

Day 15 – March 27, Saturday: Cairo—Pyramids of Giza, Sphinx, Grand Egyptian Museum, Civilization Museum, Cairo Bazaar

Our morning begins exploring the only one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World still standing, the **Pyramids of Giza**. We'll also visit the **Sphinx**, marveling at these enduring symbols of ancient civilization. We then continue to the new **Grand Egyptian Museum**, home to an extraordinary collection of ancient artifacts including the treasures of King Tutankhamun. From here, we visit the **National Museum of Egyptian Civilization**, where we'll see the **Royal Mummies Hall** and come face-to-face with some of Egypt's most significant rulers. After some time to shop in **Cairo's Bazaar**, we return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

Day 16 – March 28, Sunday: Flight Home

After breakfast, we depart Egypt for our flight(s) home.
